Private funeral to be held soon for Cedrika Provencher

The family of Cédrika Provencher will finally hold a funeral for the girl who was abducted and murdered in July 2007.

Cédrika's bones were discovered about eight months ago, and were given to the family in recent days after being analyzed by experts.

In a statement issued Tuesday by the Missing Children's Network, Director General Pina Arcamone said that after nine "long and painful" years trying to find their little Cédrika, the time has come for her parents, Karine Fortier and Martin Provencher, to say farewell.
